



What is the purpose of the information?
Is it to inform, persuade, present an opinion, report research, or sell something? For what audience is it intended? Does it show bias? Is the material popular or scholarly?

Is the information timely?
When was the information published? Is the date of publication important to the subject matter? Does the information need to be updated using other sources?

This is also the time to whittle down your sources to those that directly relate to your topic. In the "old days" students used to worry about not having sufficient resources. Now, students have too many to choose from! Make an A-list pile (those sources that you are sure you will need) and a B-list pile (those sources you might need). Anything else should be tossed or put out of sight so you are not sidetracked. Review your thesis statement or search statement if you are having trouble weeding your research.

Giving Credit
When you use the words or original ideas of another person in your writing, you need to document, or give credit to, the sources of those words or ideas. If exact words from the original are used, quotation marks are necessary. If you paraphrase, or restate the idea in your own words, quotation marks are not required, but documentation of the source is still required.

Avoiding Plagiarism
Copying someone else's work or ideas and misrepresenting them as your own is called plagiarism. Committing plagiarism, whether intentionally or unintentionally, is a violation of academic integrity and can result in suspension from school. The best way to avoid plagiarism is to:

- Take good notes and record important citation information (author, titles, dates, pages, etc.)
- Avoid copying and pasting from the Web and other electronic resources
- Use your own ideas and words
- Give credit for copied, adapted, or paraphrased material using a proper citation style




