
Raising Money for Power Adjustable Seat Height




4. Fill out the information for your campaign:




Step 7. Share your campaign! Share via email, on social media sites and with family and friends. The more you share, the better chance of donations.

Raising money for someone else?


If you select 'Someone Else', you will remain in control of the campaign, but the money you raise will be sent to the person you enter on the next step.

Still not sure?


If you don't want to decide now, you will have this option throughout your campaign. Click here to decide later.
